- 2. A personal statement of no more than 500 words on future educational and career plans and how the proposed internship will be of help in achieving those goals
- 3. A resume or CV

In selecting the scholarship recipient, the committee will consider the following elements:

- 1. The recipient must be a full-time student and participating in unpaid foreign affairs internships
- 2. The recipient must be in good standing with the Burnett Honors College when the scholarship is awarded
- 3. Preference will be given to those students interning with the U.S. State Department, United Nations, NATO or other non-governmental organizations (NGOs)

Applicants should be advised that this award may affect their financial assistance status.
