## THE BURNETT HONORS COLLEGE EMERGING LEADER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- 3. A resume or CV

In selecting the scholarship recipient, the committee will consider the following elements:

- 1. The recipient must be a full-time student in The Burnett Honors College, and have completed two semesters at UCF
- 2. Students must be STEM or Social Science majors
- 3. The recipient must have a GPA of at least 3.5 of higher
- 4. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen
- 5. Application will demonstrate ability in two of the three categories: Leadership, Public Service, Research
