- 2. A personal statement of no more than 500 words on the following question: In your opinion, what is the relationship between art and the lived experience of women and/or other underrepresented minorities?
- 3. A resume or CV.

In selecting the scholarship recipient, the committee will consider the following elements:

- 1. The recipient must be a full-time student in The Burnett Honors College and have completed two semesters at UCF.
- 2. This award is open to all majors, but preference will be given to underrepresented minorities and women in the arts and art education.
- 3. The recipient must have a GPA of at least 3.5 or higher.
- 4. The recipient must be a U.S. citizen.

Applicants should be advised that this award may affect their financial assistance status.
