<i>Thesis Defense</i> We strongly recommend that students submit a final copy of their thesis to their committee for review at least two weeks prior to their scheduled defense date. Students must submit a copy of their Notice of Defense to the Office of Honors Research at least one week before their scheduled oral defense date. See the template in the HUT Webcourse.
