

2025 Team Leader Program Application Packet

Honors Symposium is designed to assist new Honors students in fostering a sense of Honors community and identity, in making campus connections, and in developing professional skills and values. As a Team Leader, you will become an integral part of this course, serving as a mentor to these students, and working collaboratively with the staff of the Burnett Honors College. Team Leaders receive training the week before the semester and meet each week to discuss the class. Team Leaders have approximately 17 students in their section.

Team Leaders will be responsible for:

- Attending their assigned Symposium Night (Monday or Tuesday 4:30PM-6:50PM), pre-class meetings at 4:00PM, and weekly TL meetings on Thursdays from 5:00PM-6:00PM.
- Serving as role models for appropriate academic, leadership, and personal behavior and as a mentor and resource for their students.
- Leading breakout discussions with their team members and promoting campus involvement opportunities.
- Communicating with their team members outside of class each week.
- Attending all required trainings and meetings related to the Team Leader Program, including:
 - Spring Kickoff on Friday, April 4th from 3:00PM-5:00PM
 - ➤ Team Leader Retreat on August 12th-14th from 8:00AM-5:00PM
- Performing related duties as assigned.

Team Leaders will gain:

- Enhanced leadership, public speaking, time management, team building, and interpersonal skills.
- Increased knowledge and experience in mentorship.
- Insight into the organization and goals of a university course.
- Employment experience in the Burnett Honors College.
- Extensive knowledge and understanding of the Burnett Honors College and the UCF community.
- Lasting friendships.

To be eligible for the program, you must:

- Be a University Honors student in good standing.
- Have successfully completed Honors Symposium.
- Be a student who has not previously served two terms as a Team Leader.
- Demonstrate characteristics consistent with the goals and objectives of Honors Symposium including integrity, dependability, punctuality, and dedication to the program.
- Show a commitment to campus involvement and community engagement.
- Possess effective communication and interpersonal skills and a desire to further develop those skills throughout the training process.

- Group interviews will be held the weeks of February 24th and March 3rd. If selected for an interview you will receive an email with a link to select your preferred interview date and time.
