The Inspire Scholarship provides a 4-year Florida Prepaid tuition and residence hall housing award. The Florida Prepaid package, along with Bright Futures, will allow students to cover the full cost of attendance at UCF, including tuition, housing, meal plan, fees, and books. In addition, Inspire Scholars receive up to \$5,000 to use for co-curricular and professional development opportunities such as study abroad, undergraduate research, and internships.

Inspire Scholars join the Burnett Honors College as first-time in college (FTIC) freshmen, and benefit from Honors classes and Honors resources. University Honors is a four-year program designed to offer a small college experience within a large research university. The Inspire Scholars program also builds a special community and provides additional mentoring and advising. January 21: Take Stock in Children local program submits application and recommendation letter to the drop box for Burnett Honors College.

February: Semifinalists are notified and Zoom interviews are scheduled. Applicant must submit FAFSA to UCF by *Feb. 15*

March 13: Finalists are notified.

April 20: Students must indicate acceptance of Inspire Scholarship and submit UCF Enrollment Deposit to commit to UCF.

Inspire Scholar applicants can also be considered for admission to the Burnett Honors College even if they are not awarded the Inspire Scholarship.
