Burnett Honors College Outcomes and Data

The Burnett Honors College's (BHC) strategic focus on high-impact practices, robust advising, and national recognition has created a powerful ecosystem for student success. BHC Scholars consistently report higher engagement in internships, leadership, research, and campus involvement compared to their non-honors peers. The integrations of career development through TALENT, healthcare pathways through CARES, and research opportunities through OHRSE ensure that every BHC Scholar has access to transformative experiences aligned with their professional goals.

The **TALENT program** (Transforming Aspiring Leaders through Experience, Networking, and Training), established in 2019, serves as a cornerstone for career and professional development. TALENT connects Scholars with industry leaders, alumni mentors, and internship opportunities through curated programming such as networking events, career panels, etiquette workshops, and individualized mentorship.

BHC graduates consistently report higher starting salaries than non-honors peers, with median salaries ranging from \$71,648 to \$75,000 and maximum reported salaries reaching \$225,000. These outcomes are directly linked to the experiential learning and professional development facilitated by programs like TALENT. BHC's emphasis on internships and networking gives its graduates a competitive edge in the job market.

The **CARES program** (Clinical Activity, Research Experience, and Shadowing) is designed for Scholars who plan to pursue careers in healthcare. CARES helps Scholars learn more about the application and placement process for shadowing, internships, and volunteering in addition to creating connections with professionals in the medical field.

CARES also hosts networking events on campus that connect Scholars with healthcare organizations. The BHC Medical Research Scholars program, established in 2024, allows pre-health students and those in other majors to pursue research on-site at Orlando Health facilities under the guidance of physician researchers and full-time research scientists. The program offers biannual meetings with the UCF College of Medicine to demystify the medical school application process and provides medical school mock interviews.

Undergraduate research plays a critical role in shaping post-baccalaureate outcomes by fostering analytical thinking, problem-solving, and hands-on experience. Engaging in research enhances students' academic confidence, deepens subject matter expertise, and often leads to stronger mentorship and professional networks. These experiences prepare students to contribute meaningfully in advanced study and professional environments. BHC alumni pursue graduate studies at UCF and other prestigious institutions nationwide, including Ivy League and top public universities.

The **Burnett Honors College** will further enhance its outcomes and remain a leader in honors education by deepening experiential learning, expanding research and clinical partnerships, strengthening professional networks, and championing student well-being.

Self-Report Engagement While at UCF: First Destination Survey

BHC Scholars report higher engagement than non-BHC peers in most areas: internships, leadership roles, research, honorary societies, and study abroad. The BHC fosters strong academic and extracurricular engagement, especially in leadership, study abroad, and research. Notably, BHC Scholars are less likely to be employed full-time off campus or join fraternities/sororities.

High Impact Practices

There is 100% participation of BHC Scholars in university-designated high impact practices (HIPs). Additionally, 61.2% completed two or more HIPs, 28.2% completed three or more, and 7.5% completed four or more HIPs, indicating substantial depth of engagement.

Plans after Graduation: BHC Scholars

Self-Report Salary for First Job after Graduation: First Destination Survey

University Honors graduates consistently report higher average and median starting salaries than non-honors peers, with a marginal differential ranging from 13% to 32%. The 2024-25 survey had fewer respondents due to softening of the labor market and late offers, which may affect data reliability. Median and average salaries for BHC graduates remain strong (\$71K–\$81K), with some graduates earning up to \$225K. BHC graduates are competitive in the job market, with consistently high earning potential. Data below reflects self-reported responses to the University Honors exit survey.

Self-Report Location of First Job after Graduation: First Destination Survey

A majority of BHC graduates find jobs in Florida (59–88%), with a lower percentage working in Central Florida (45–59%). Non-honors graduates are even more likely to stay in Florida and Central Florida. BHC graduates are mobile, but most remain in-state, supporting the regional talent pipeline.
